A Light in Darkness

You will see LED candles in the windows of 840 Maus Ave during January. They glow at this former Planned Parenthood location to commemorate the millions of the lives lost to abortion, especially since our Supreme Court's Roe v. Wade decision on January 22, 1973.

We remember these children's brief lives, and mourn their loss, by daily providing support for mothers to choose life. In March 2018 Family Life Services moved our life-affirming ministry to this building. Now women and their children both find here respect and resources to help them thrive.

Clients often tell us they have no support to help them through their pregnancy and with parenting. A recent client who received emergency groceries, a sonogram, referrals to other area resources, and a Hope Clinic Food Bank appointment, told us before she left, *"I feel like you really care for me here."* You, our supporters, make this possible.
